



Education and Outreach Internship

Position

The museum is seeking interns to focus on educational programming. The position will be for a minimum of 2.5 days per week and be completed over a 14-week period. The intern will choose from one of the following projects:

- Developing a traveling/virtual education program
- Developing hands-on educational activities
- Developing a new tour program based on current exhibitions

Tasks for these projects may include, but are not limited to:

- Leading group tours
- Reaching out to schools, camps, and other educational institutions
- Collaborating with partner institutions to create multi-faceted educational experiences

Learning Objectives

The intern will learn about and acquire hands-on skills in museum education, development of educational materials, and participating in outreach and collaboration.

Other Benefits

The National Museum of Dentistry is a Smithsonian Affiliate and will provide opportunities for the intern to learn from and collaborate with faculty and staff across the Smithsonian Institution.

Minimum Requirements + Skills

- A degree in or currently pursuing a degree in museum studies, history, or education
- Expertise with MS Office applications (desirable)

Application Process

The internship is open to students currently enrolled at an accredited college or university, pursuing a Bachelor's or Master's degree in a course of study related to museums, archives, cultural site management, non-profit management or public history.
